

This document provides the list of feature class (layer) names and the meaning of each one. The names of each 'type' of location as based on the legend from the original map which was digitized for this project:

* The feature classes labeled as 'master' include every country layer combined into one shapefile and attribute table for easy toggling.

* The feature classes labeled using the form above are broken down by each country where comfort stations were on the map. This separation was done using the administrative boundaries of each country at the level of 0 (in the form of a shapefile).

* Any feature class using the above form contains the buffers (mentioned in the Digitization Process documentation) for each individual comfort station. These buffers are broken down by country as well.
